

Payphone TTY ST120

The payphone TTY (telephone typewriter) ST120 when connected to a Telstra payphone, as pictured below, is for use by a Deaf, hearing impaired or speech impaired person to communicate via the telecommunications network.

The **ST120** is installed on the bench alongside a public payphone, the user places the payphone handset onto the two acoustic cups of the **ST120** and inserts coins or a phone card into the payphone to obtain a line and make the call.

The keyboard of the **ST120** is used to type text conversation to another TTY user or to the National Relay Service* for voice relay by a trained operator to a hearing person.

FEATURES

- Easy to read 20 character bright florescent displays text conversation, metal keypad with under keyboard protector to reduce liquid spill damage.
- Acoustic cups to suit a Telstra payphone, powered by a 12 Volt DC transformer – 240V mains power source.
- Voice Announcer – announces "hearing impaired caller, please use TTY", separate GA key.
- Review message during call – TTY records conversation in memory during call. Privacy ensured – memory erased when turned off.
- Rugged long lasting metal outer case, TTY does not require separate wiring to connect to the payphone – handset of payphone sits in the acoustic cups of the TTY.
- Conditional 12 months – back to supplier warranty, USA and UK compatible - fitted with both 50 and 45.5 baud.
- Inexpensive public access to a TTY facility.

Public Access

Ideal for any public access location where reasonable security exists, eg; hospitals, civic centres, entertainment venues, conference centres, police stations, government front office, customer service counters and public libraries.

Discrimination Disability Act 1992

Consider the requirements under the Discrimination Disability Act 1992 to provide access to your services by people with a disability. The ST120 should be for consideration as part of your Access Policy for Deaf, hearing impaired and speech impaired people in the community.

The National Relay Service will relay by voice a TTY or modem conversation to a hearing person or by text from a voice conversation to a TTY or modem user.
